<p><b>Aims:</b></p> <p><b>Did your objectives for coming to this training have been met?</b></p>	<p>The vast majority of participants have cited that the course fulfilled their expectations.</p> <p>The set goal of all the listeners was to acquire new information from the area of R &amp; D projects, innovations and technical transfer.</p>
<p><b>Coverage:</b></p> <p><b>Is there anything else you would like the events to have covered?</b></p>	<p>The vast majority of participants have stated that the course was comprehensive by the scope of the topics.</p> <p>Almost 30% of learners have mentioned, as a recommendation, to apply the theoretical knowledge more into practice with examples of specific projects.</p>



<p><b>Achievements:</b></p> <p><b>What are, according to you, the major achievements of this training initiative?</b></p>	<p>The majority of participants have stated that the acquisition of new information from the taught issues, the information on sources of professional literature were the greatest benefits.</p> <p>Almost all of the participants have cited that the training course was beneficial for them in respect to the acquisition of new information and knowledge.</p> <p>Any of the students did not mention negative feelings.</p> <p>The responses showed that the participants were addressed by the attractiveness of the topic itself.</p>
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**SUGGESTIONS: what to keep next time, what to change next time:**

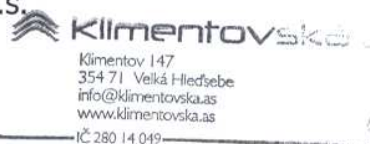
In general the participants have stated that they would keep the course in its present form. The recommendation, which has appeared the most often (62% of participants), was to apply practical examples in the lectures and to involve students in the discussions, to include more of interactivity between the lecturer and students.



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
